### Third Grade

Community Supplies – all the items below will be shared in the classroom. Students will not keep these at their desk.

- \_\_\_ 60 TICONDEROGA sharpened #2 pencils
- \_\_\_ 1 box (24 count) of crayons
- \_\_\_ 2 large pink erasers (not “Foohy” kind)
- \_\_\_ 2 small glue sticks
- \_\_\_ 2 regular size boxes of Kleenex
- \_\_\_ 4 red correcting pens
- \_\_\_ 1 pkg. wide-ruled binder paper
- \_\_\_ 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks (solid colored please)
- \_\_\_ 4 highlighters any color
- \_\_\_ 1 pkg. colored pencils – Crayola or Crayola Twistable
- \_\_\_ 1 pkg. of 10 count markers
- \_\_\_ 2 BLACK dry erase markers

Personal Supplies – students personally keep these.

- \_\_\_ Backpack (NO WHEELS)
- \_\_\_ Large, nylon, sturdy pencil pouch for binder (NO PENCIL BOXES)
- \_\_\_ 1 black fine point Sharpie
- \_\_\_ 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars work best)

## Binder Setup Instructions

Your child will be using a 3-ring finder this year. This can be quite a challenge. It must be at school daily and is an important part of your child's study skills program. PLEASE check frequently to see the binder is complete (please do not remove items from behind tabs; we will be revisiting these materials) and ORGANIZED!

Prior to the first day of school the dividers should be labeled as following, starting from the beginning of the binder and progressing toward the back. It is easiest if the first section's divider is the one closest to the top of the page.
