Mark your calendars for our first ever **Kids at Hope Destination Night!** We are very excited to offer this event on **Thursday, March 22, 2018 from 6:00 pm - 7:30 pm at Sunset View.** You will start the evening by collecting your very own Kids at Hope Destination Passport. Then you will travel through the **four destinations (Home and Family, Education and Career, Communities and Service, Hobbies and Recreation)** as you walk throughout the building. There will also be community booths set up throughout the building for you to visit, connecting to each destination. (On the back of this letter you will find a list of the activities and the community partners involved.) You will find a location in each destination where students can get their passport stamped.
